

Ayşe Nordal is senior advisor for strategic planning and risk management at the Municipal Undertaking for Educational Buildings and Property in Oslo- Norway (Undervisningsbygg Oslo KF), the owner and operator of 1, 4 million square meters of real estate consisting of 177 schools and 750 buildings. The booked value of Undervisningsbygg's portfolio is NOK 24 billions.
